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## Art with Abrakadoodle Spring 2024 Semester at a Glance

Lesson	Artist	Lesson/Activity
1	None	Snail Doodle Develop Spiral curve that winds around one center point using multi-colored clay (model magic) to create a snail.
2	None	Patterned Still Life Doodle Drawing and arranging everyday objects to setup their artwork composition.
3	None	Relief Sculpture Doodle Create a sculpture where a surface is raised to stand out from the surrounding background using various techniques.
4	None	Cloud Doodle Creating a cloud using a stencil and paint using monochromatic colors (shades of the same color) and then add objects they would find in the sky.
5	None	Stamped Clay Bowl Doodle Children will create 'Functional Art' where the object is decorative but serves a purpose.
6	None	Bubble Doodle Using drawing chalk and paint to create transparent and overlapping bubbles on black construction paper.
7	None	Model Magic Owl Doodle Paint the canvas board black with glitter glue and form & paint their owl with Model Magic and place flattened on the canvas board.
8	Kuna Indians in Panama	Moia Doodle Create a Moia (geometric patterns) using bilateral and rotational symmetry rotating the same design around the paper quadrants using tracing paper and completing with Oil Pastels.
9	None	Tube Bird Doodle Learn about a color wheel and tinting when developing their 'tube' bird with model magic, markers and tempera paint.
10	Creative Inspiration: What artist and/or culture and/or Story inspired you the most during the previous 9 weeks?	Showcase / Artist Challenge Children will select the materials for their creative inspiration and parents will be invited to join in on the fun.
